

# CODEGREEN

**We're serious about being GREEN in Tunica, but we want to make sure we do it right so we're making small changes, a little at a time. This year we focused on Harrah's (details below) and we're just getting started at Roadhouse with cardboard recycling. Horseshoe is next so look for more great results coming soon!**

- All thermostats in Harrah's hotel rooms have been changed to new models that limit the temperature settings and run time on the A/C units.
- All Harrah's hotel room lighting has been changed over from 60 watt incandescent lighting to 13 watt compact fluorescents.
- All Harrah's back of house ballasts, which energize the lights, have been changed over from T12 to T8 models, which are much more energy efficient.
- All Harrah's 75 to 100 MR16 light fixtures have been removed from the floor and existing lighting has been repositioned to have a greater effect.
- At Harrah's we've gone to a 3 watt cold cathode bulb from the old 25 watt popcorn bulb on the exterior of the building - which resulted in the changing out of 5000 bulbs for more efficient models.
- At Harrah's we've changed out all the flush valves in the hotel toilets from the old 5 gallon models to the newer 1.6 gallon per flush units - all 1366 rooms!!!
- All shower heads in the hotels at Harrah's have also been changed to the low-flo 2.5 gallon units from the old 5 gallon units. Again - all 1366 rooms!!!
- We have switched over to an environmentally friendly chemical to treat the water that services our A/C cooling towers at Harrah's.
- Motion-sensing light switches have been installed in all electrical and mechanical rooms at Harrah's to automatically shut lights off when the room is unoccupied.
- Since early 2010, more than 71 tons of cardboard have been recycled. This is equal in weight to one of the stones at the ancient pyramids at Giza and more than 10 tons heavier than an M1 Abrams tank!
